**JOIN THE SAN ANTONIO LIFE CHAIN OCTOBER 7, 2018 ON SAN PEDRO BETWEEN 410 AND
BASSE FROM 2-3PM.**

Join us on October 7, 2018 for the 31st annual Life Chain San Antonio event. Life Chain San Antonio's opening ceremonies will take place from 1:30-1:55pm with the "life chains" forming afterwards from 2:00-3:00pm¹. This is a time for our local community to stand together with others around the nation to protest the evil of abortion and to contend publicly for the unborn victims.

Local voices are important, particularly in San Antonio. Mayor Ron Nirenberg and the City Council have historically been abortion supporters and have even voted to target teen minority girls with abortifacients such as Depo-Provera and Nexplanon. In 2015, during the opposition of the relocation and expansion of Planned Parenthood to the Dreamhill Estates residential area, then District 8 Councilman, Ron Nirenberg, reportedly stated, "Planned Parenthood deserves to be here." Further support for abortion as an acceptable practice has been demonstrated by now Mayor Ron Nirenberg and the current City Council, this year, hiring Planned Parenthood Abortionist Chi Chi Junda Woo to be the head of the Bexar County Metropolitan Health District.

Perhaps more than any other city in Texas, your voices are needed to communicate to our leaders that abortion isn't healthcare, and that the people of San Antonio stand with the unborn and not with those who fund abortion, target minority babies, and who ignore the voices of their constituents who do not desire to have an abortion facility where the lives of children are taken, located within 50 feet of their homes. The leadership of the City of San Antonio is on the record as abortion supporters and worse, abortion facilitators. Join us as we send the message to them that the citizens of San Antonio do not stand with them on this issue.

Consider also the 60,069,971 children who have been killed in America since the Roe decision. This number is simply staggering. During the Holocaust in Germany, 9 million Jews were killed and the world was horrified and it was resolved that such evil would not happen again. Yet, within less than 30 years of the WWII, we in America legalized the same type of eugenic policy that led to the extermination of the Jews. Abortion in America like the eugenics in Germany targets minority populations disproportionately and keeps the black population at approximately 13%. As noted above, abortifacient drugs were approved by the Mayor and City Council for lower income minority teens. Such populations have always been the target of Planned Parenthood and their allies in government.

¹ This year the Life Chain has expanded. In addition to the Traditional Location on San Pedro, chains will form on the West and North East sides of San Antonio. The west side chain will be located at Village Parkway Baptist Church at 3002 Village Parkway and Culebra. The Northeast side chain will form at Judson and Nacogdoches. It is initiated by the Vietnamese Christian Church, located on Judson.
